Dear Parent or Guardian,

This letter is to inform you that beginning in the second quarter the Brandon-Evansville Middle School staff will be implementing a new detention policy. Detentions issued by staff members will be reported to the administration. An email, as well as a letter will be sent home if your student is issued a detention describing the incident. Below is a list of the Middle School Detention Policy, as well as Detention Rules. Detentions may be served after school (3:00-4:00) on Tuesdays or before school (7:00-8:00) on Thursdays. Arrangements must be made for your student to serve their detention within a week of issue. If your student does not serve their detention within one week they will receive an additional detention. An accumulation of three unserved detentions will result in one full day of In School Suspension.

Detention Policy

1. Verbal warning
2. Removal from class = automatic detention
 - a. Teachers may issue detentions for behaviors without removing student from class.
3. Three tardies to one class will result in a detention.
4. Three after school detentions will result in a meeting with parents and administration.

Detention Rules

1. Be on Time
2. Students MUST be working on school assignments or reading a book.
3. Must be served in the assigned area
4. No Food or Beverages Allowed
5. No Sleeping
6. No Talking
7. No Devices

ANY STUDENT REMOVED FROM DETENTION FOR INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR WILL NOT RECEIVE CREDIT FOR HOUR SERVED AND WILL BE ASSIGNED AN ADDITIONAL SIXTY MINUTES.
